Cremation Remains Placed in a Specific Two Niche Columbarium Unit

If you would like to purchase a two niche columbarium unit that is a part of the Honor Park Memorial Area, and placing your cremation remains in it upon your death, we have dedicated lots 9, 10, 13, and 14 for these columbarium units in Section 10. In order to make the Honor Park Memorial Area look unique and beautiful, all of the two niche columbarium units within these lots will be of the same design. There are only ten of these units available in lots 9 and 10. After all ten units have been sold, we plan to install sixteen additional units of the same design in lots 13 and 14. These units can be purchased from Arlington East Hill Cemetery Association for a total price of \$4,200 each. However, these prices are subject to change without notice. The package includes the columbarium unit, foundation, space, engraving of names, and sales tax. In addition, it will cost \$200 to open and close the niche during the week or \$250 to open and close the niche on a Saturday or Holidays. Full payment of \$4,200 is due upon the purchase of the unit. The payment for the open and close is due at the time of service. It is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone to provide insurance coverage if desired. Otherwise, any damage is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone.

Cremation Remains Placed in a Two Niche Columbarium Unit

If you prefer placing the cremation remains in a headstone that is made specifically to hold cremation remains within the Honor Park, we have dedicated 86 spaces for these columbarium units in Section 10. The columbarium units located in this area of the Honor Park do not have to be of the same design as the units in lots 9, 10, 13 and 14, but must have two niches. The cost of the space is \$600. The foundation required in the Honor Park for each space is 50"X24" and will cost \$720. The unit, including engraving, will be purchased from a vendor other than Arlington East Hill Cemetery Association and the cost is not known. In addition, it will cost \$200 to open and close the niche during the week or \$250 to open and close the niche on a Saturday or Holidays. Full payment for the space and foundation is due upon the purchase of the space. The payment for the open and close is due at the time of service. It is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone to provide insurance coverage if desired. Otherwise, any damage is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone.

Cremation Burial

If you prefer placing the cremation remains in a cement vault provided by our cemetery and burying it in the ground within our Honor Park, we have dedicated 88 spaces in Section 10 for cremation burials and traditional burials. The cost of the burial space is \$600. One space will be needed for both the veteran or first responder and the spouse due to the fact that we can bury two cremation vaults in one space. The foundation required in the Honor Park for each space is 50"X24" and will cost \$720. The headstone, including engraving, will be purchased from a vendor other than Arlington East Hill Cemetery Association and the cost is not known. In addition, it will cost \$600 to open and close the grave during the week or \$650 to open and close the grave on a Saturday or Holidays. Full payment for the burial space and foundation is due upon the purchase of the burial space. The payment for the open and close is due at the time of service. It is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone to provide insurance coverage if desired. Otherwise, any damage is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone.

Traditional Burial

If you prefer a traditional burial in our Honor Park, we have dedicated 88 spaces in Section 10 for traditional burials and cremation burials. The cost of the burial space is \$600. One space will be needed for the veteran or first responder and one space will be needed for the spouse. The foundation required in the Honor Park for each space is 50"X24" and will cost \$720 each. The headstone, including engraving, will be purchased from a vendor other than Arlington East Hill Cemetery Association and the cost is not known. In addition, it will cost \$800 to open and close the grave if the service is during the week and \$850 if the service is during a Saturday or Holidays. Full payment for the burial space and foundation is due upon the purchase of the burial space. The payment for the open and close is due at the time of service. It is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone to provide insurance coverage if desired. Otherwise, any damage is the responsibility of the owner of the headstone.
